SPRING GIFT DAY - Sunday March 20th. As usual this gift day will be for our internal needs as a church. The building needs some projects tackling - such as replacement blinds in the main hall and double-glazing in the back hall as well as a new digital recorder. We have a number of outreach events planned - including the Mark drama (see below) and BOB's guest speaker. The new congregation may well need some extra funding as they begin to look at how they are going to reach out with the gospel. Please come ready to give.
