Update for all you Tearfund Quizzers: Following the Tearfund Quiz which we took part in last November, we've had an update from Tearfund to say that more than 600 churches joined in, with 26,384 people taking part. In total, an outstanding £210,000 was raised to help people living in poverty. The money raised is enough to provide 909 families with the practical and emotional support they need to recover from the trauma of conflict and displacement. Thank you for taking part and let's continue to pray for the crucial work that Tearfund is doing for some of the world's poorest people.
