This week please pray for the **Gideons UK:**

Give thanks that God is still honouring His promise (Isaiah 55 :11) that His word will not return to Him void as people are being saved by reading Bibles or Testaments provided by the Gideons UK, who, in turn, are supported by churches such as Woodlands. The Gideon work started in Britain 70 years ago and we recently celebrated with the theme "Great is Your faithfulness."

Please pray about the distribution of Youth Testaments – both locally and nationally. Increasingly schools are refusing access and even in the schools which are open the uptake by pupils is diminishing. Over these past 70 years schools work has been so important in getting God's word into people's hands and homes.
