A couple in our church were contacted by different people pretending to offer discounts and then by another pretending to be an anti-fraud department. It is very important not to give out any personal details to people over the phone if you are unsure of who they are. The police have asked us to make this known to as many as possible to warn of the danger of these telephone scams.

Church family news

Oliver Ward: Following the special church meeting on Wednesday, we can confirm that out of the 141 votes cast, 136, (96.5%), were in support of the recommendation that we appoint Oli Ward as the next full-time pastor at Woodlands Evangelical Church. This was well in excess of the 85% required by the church constitution. We will therefore be going ahead with the appointment and expect Oli to be in place by September. He is delighted with the outcome and is looking forward to working with us in due course.

Beth Arnold: We are also pleased to confirm that Beth Arnold, our current Ministry Trainee, will be staying on with us in a full-time paid capacity as a Youth and Children's worker initially on a one-year contract. We will continue to look for an overall Youth and Schools worker to replace Thiago. Beth has already made a significant contribution to the work amongst our young people and we are thrilled that she will continue working with us.

Annual Leave: Tim Gunn will be on leave from Thursday 4th - Sunday 21st July inclusive.
