Grateful people in Rwanda: I spent the first three weeks of June working with the Anglican Church in Rwanda. My brief was working with the rural development and community transformation department. This involved training sessions in rural areas which were all well attended with over 150 people in total. I also assisted with Saturday workshops for school teachers, plus some advice on land use. The rural poor who came to the training sessions were very grateful for the support provided by Woodlands for a mid-day meal. This was my first visit to Rwanda, a nation recovering from the 1994 genocide, yet a place where the church is growing and expanding rapidly and enlarging or erecting new buildings, as many people come to faith in Jesus.
