- We will care for, value, and love each other and carry each other's burdens

#### AIM: to see all members in discipling relationships

#### 4. Serving together 'Serve one another humbly in love' Galatians 5:13

- We will identify our individual gifts and use them in the life of the church
- We will train people in the use of their gifts
- We will publicise all the areas of service where gifted people are needed
- We will set up 'teams' of people in all these areas

#### AIM: to see all members serving in at least one area of church life

#### 5. Witnessing together 'Always be prepared to give an answer' 1 Peter 3:15

- · We will encourage everyone to be involved in the work of evangelism
- · We will give specific training on how to share the good news
- · We will run formal courses for outsiders which explain the good news
- We will be involved in external mission activity both in the UK and overseas
